Underdog Kootenay team medals at B.C. soccer championship

Kootenay South Youth Soccer's U16 Boys team rose to the occasion and captured bronze in dramatic fashion in the U17 division of the BC Soccer provincial championship in Kamloops last week.
The KSYSA 16 Boys team went into

the tournament as the proverbial underdog, as they were playing in the U17

The team responded and rallied, The boys played hard, ending the scoring five goals in a 5-2 victory over Shuswap.



Open Board Positions

Help us continue to move forward by joining the board! Here are some brief notes about open board positions.

President

- presides at all meetings of the members of the Club and meetings of the Board
- shall coordinate all duties of the Board, committees, and staff; and shall be the spokesperson for the Club
- ensures Association is in compliance of Grassroots, BC Soccer, and Canada Soccer standards
- communicates with Crowe and Stanley Humphries regarding the KSYSA scholarship.
 Reviews applications and forms a group of directors to decide on recipients
- answers the KSYSA info email

Vice President

- shall act in the absence of the President and shall have other powers as assigned by the Board
- sits on Discipline Committee

Treasurer

- · pays KSYSA invoices upon approval of the board
- ensure that complete and accurate records are kept of the accounts of the Club
- shall report to the Board at least once per quarter; and submit an Annual Financial Report [(including budget)] at annual meetings of the members
- provides financial information to accountants

<u>Development Director</u>

- works with the technical director to support the development teams
- Organize camps
- Identify and support opportunities for high performance players
- helps to recruit coaches for development teams
- Chairs Development Committee-

Youth Director

- chairs the youth committee
- schedules games & practices (BV, Castlegar, Rossland, Trail)
- obtains registration information from the Registrar and creates teams for each community
- distributes information about the season to the coaches
- helps recruit coaches for youth teams

Looking back

Prior to 1990's

Four Clubs

- Rossland Football Club, Castlegar Minor Soccer, Beaver Valley Minor Soccer, and Trail Minor Soccer.
- Each club had two members on KSYSA board
- Each club had it's own board and volunteers and managed their respective locations
- The Select (Development) program had its own committee

2017 - 2022

Amalgamation

- The KSYSA board discussed amalgamating the four clubs with the benefits of reduced volunteer asks, ability to hire help, reduced administrative requirements, etc.
- Multiple board turnovers occurred before moving forward
- In 2022, each board passed a special resolution to proceed with amalgamation. Each club would be dissolved and KSYSA would become a club within the Kootenay Rockies District.

2022-2023

Canada Quality Soccer Provider

- In 2022/23 KSYSA met all of Canada Soccer's requirements to be licensed as a quality provider to ensure that KSYSA is affiliated and sanctioned by BC soccer.
- The licensing program ensured that the club met the requirements for organization both on and off the field.

- Recruited members to fill various positions required to administer its programs
- Supported the Development program.

- Developed Team Manager Operations Manual


Next Steps
