To receive full credit, students must pass the exam (score >=70%) and attend the 7hr Classroom & Practical Session NO EXCEPTIONS. Please be mindful of the required course time commitment & confirm your availability for the Classroom & Practical Session before registering.

You will also find the cost of the course and the additional notes are worth a read to just make sure you understand what is required and how it should work.

This part is where you will build your Entry Level Refcenter profile. If you had a Small Sided Referee profile you will need to build a new profile in the Entry Level Course, as it does not work with the Small Sided Referee Profile. Please remember to change your Password completely or RefCenter will get confused between the 2 and create issues that take time to sort out and could delay in you completing the online modules on time.

- **Duration:** 80 Minutes
- **Passing Grade:** Score $\geq 70\%$
- **Allowed Attempts:** 2 (one resit is allowed 24hrs after first attempt if failed).
- **Completion Deadline:** 48hrs prior to the Practical Session.

Important: Failing to meet the completion deadline or failing twice results in course failure, and attendance at the Practical Session will not be permitted.

Click on Small Sided Rules of the Game and print off a copy, you will need for the course and for your referee kit.

Once you have started the exam you must complete the exam. 30 Questions in 80 Minutes, open book. Passing at 70% and 2 chances to pass.
